Dept of Justice, Attorney General's Public Records and Meetings Manual 2019: Public Meetings, Voting § (E)(1)(h) ORS 192.660 subsection 5 When a governing body convenes an executive session under subsection (2)(h) of this section relating to conferring with counsel on current litigation or litigation likely to be filed, the governing body shall bar any member of the news media from attending the executive session if the member of the news media is a party to the litigation or is an employee, agent or contractor of a news media organization that is a party to the litigation.
